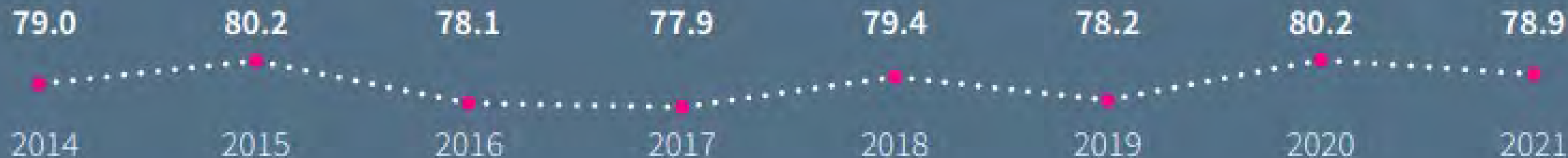
Our community wellbeing score

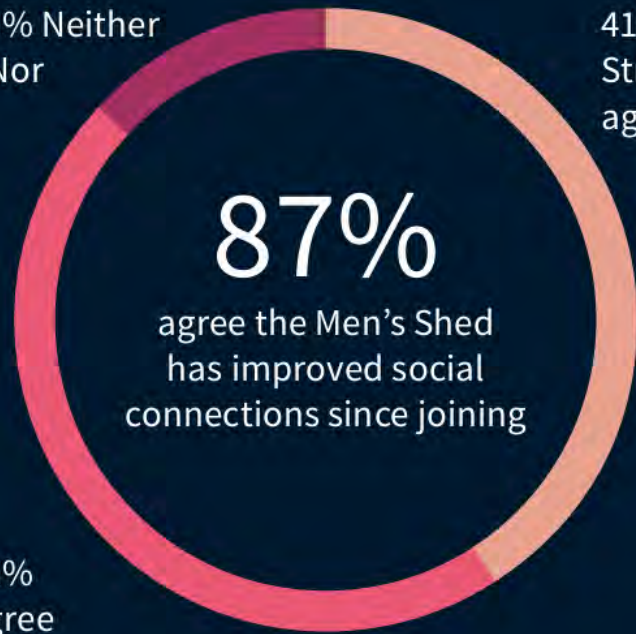
Men's Shed Participant Wellbeing
